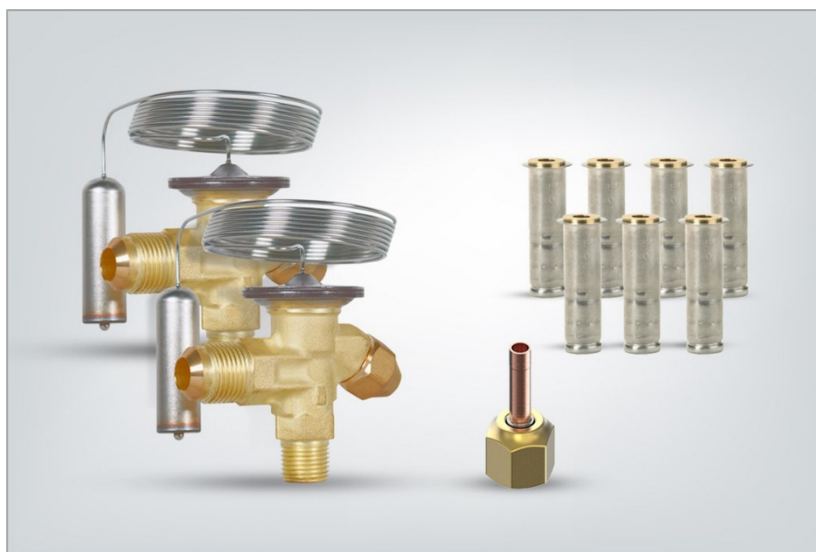
Introducing the First Thermostatic Expansion Valve for CO₂ on the Market

Danfoss is now releasing TE2 for R744, the first thermostatic expansion valve for CO₂.

This new valve is based on the well-known TE2 valve. The valve is suitable for small to medium size remote refrigeration systems such as cold rooms and display cabinets as used in convenience stores, restaurants, and small supermarkets.

The new features and functions in the update are:

- Wide temperature range
- Fast and easy to install
- Stainless steel capillary tube and bulb
- Interchangeable orifices assembly
- Long service life and easy maintenance

AK-PC 782B Pack Controller – Release of a New Product Version with Communication Over IP Towards System Manager AK-SM 800A Series



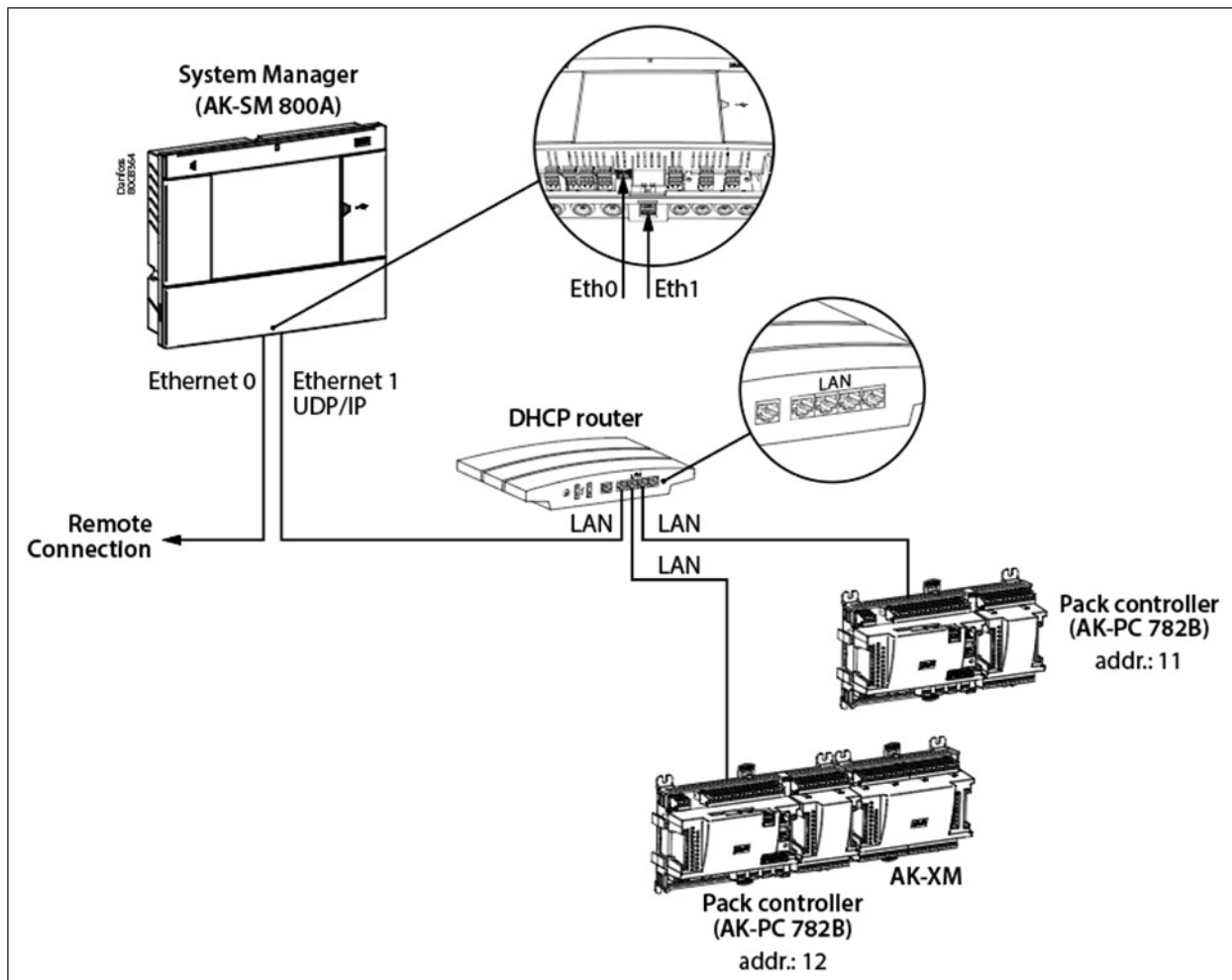
A new product version of the AK-PC 782A named as AK-PC 782B is now available, with the intention to support communication over IP towards AK-SM 800A series and overcome component scarcity of the LON chip for the existing AK-PC 782A.

AK-PC 782B with SW Ver. 3.6 code number **080Z0202** presents the same features and functionalities of the existing AK-PC 782A with SW Ver. 3.5 code number 080Z0192, with the only difference of having communication over IP towards AK-SM 800A series.

The AK-PC 782B is compatible with SW Ver. 3.6 and onwards.

Caution: this device is NOT compatible for use with software releases prior to version 3.6. Incorrect software download can permanently damage the device.

You should expect to have to set up a new network configuration for communication between the AK-PC 782B and the AK-SM 800A System Manager series as per below drawing. In the network configuration there will be the need to use a DHCP router for Pack IP addressing.

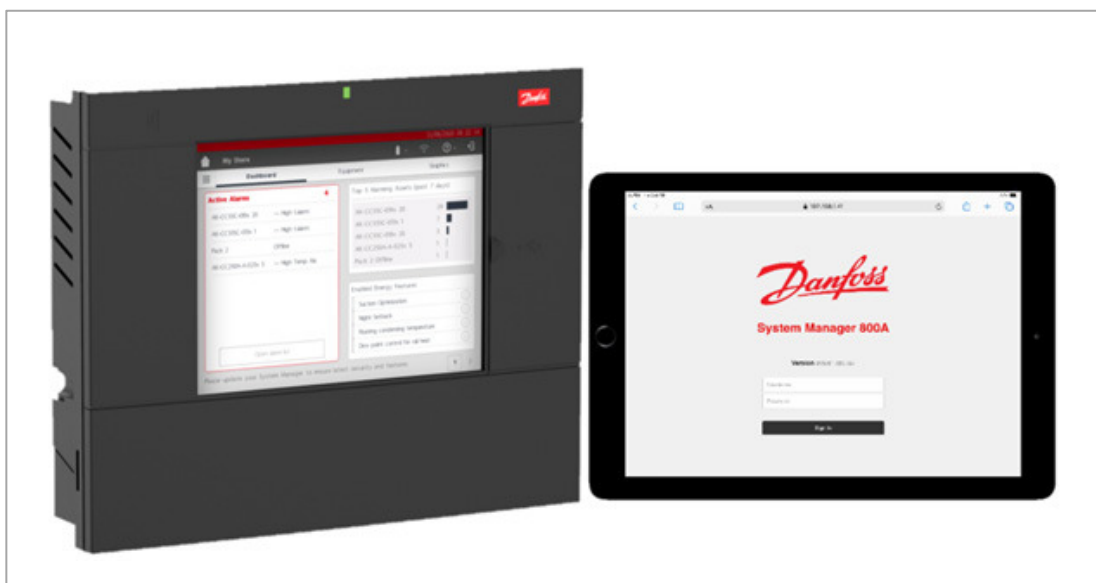
AK-SM 800A Series, Software Release 3.1 with Security Updates!

Danfoss announces a new software release of the ADAP-KOOL™ **System Manager 800A series**.

Software Package 3.1 is now available for download from [ADAP-KOOL support site](#). The software is recommended for all customers and adds new functionality, improves system reliability, security, and performance.

Special note:

For successful installation of package 3.1, a new operating system update (known as Danux 4.1.4.011.193) must be installed first – see software installation section below for more details.



Software Release 3.1 (package ID 3.1.11) details

New feature highlights

- Prepared support for new AK-PC782B IP Pack controller*, utilization of 2nd Ethernet channel
- Software support for new System Manager versions (no LON variants starting October)
- Rack control stability improvement

**The AK-PC782B IP Pack controller is expected to be launched in October 2022*

Defect fixes / update highlights

- Rack control stability improvement
- Remote comm loss fix (rare cases where IP connection is dropped by System Manager)
- Alarm e-mail continually sending out despite being ack by remote e-mail server
- Alarm e-mails not terminating after sending
- Enhanced security updates (Danux and Nginx)

Software installation

Perform a unit backup and check for any open alarms before proceeding with update.

Step 1 – update operating system (Danux 4.1.4.011.193.lpk)

- Using StoreView Browser 5 / StoreView Web select OS update and proceed with Danux upgrade.
- Allow a few minutes to pass with the new OS installed Important notes:

This file size package is large and depending on your network speed may take 10+ minutes to complete.

Do not interrupt power during the OS update.

Step 2 – update System Manager firmware (package 3.1.11.spk)

- Using StoreView Browser 5 / StoreView Web or local USB Flash drive, select OS update and proceed software upgrade.

Do not interrupt power during the software update.

- After installation is complete, review settings and correct system operation.

The new variants without LON module are aimed to reduce dependency on these scarce LON modules and to prepare our portfolio to transition towards Ethernet based setups.

All newly manufactured units will have Package 3.1.11 installed starting October.

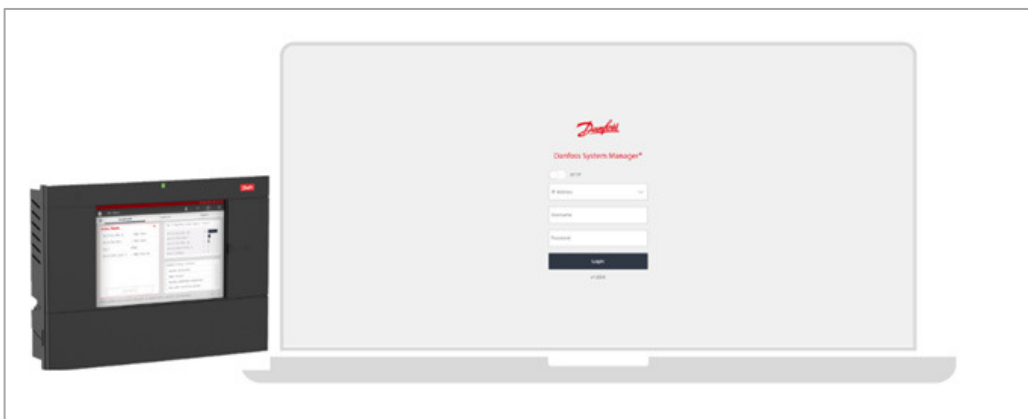

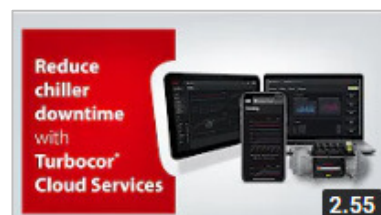
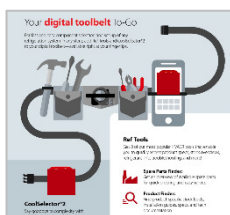
