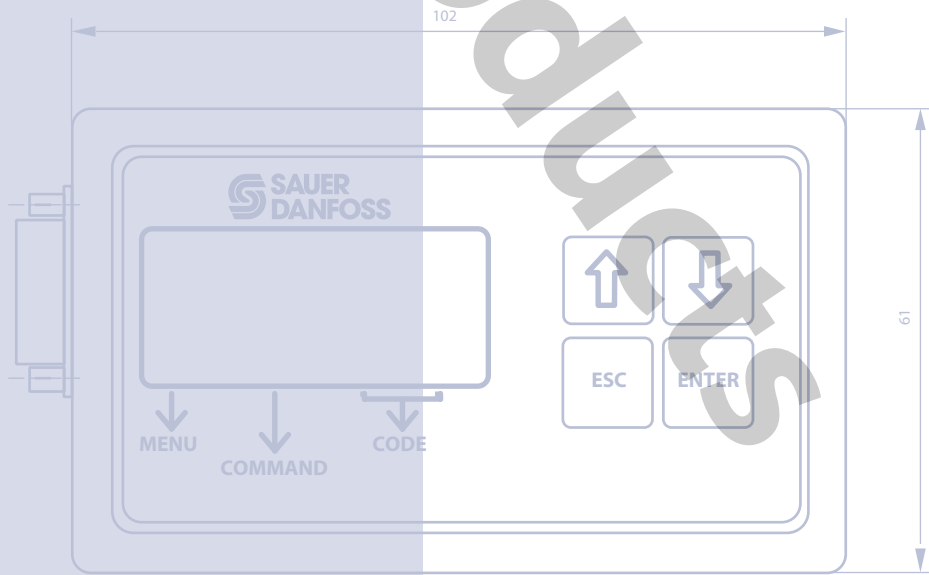
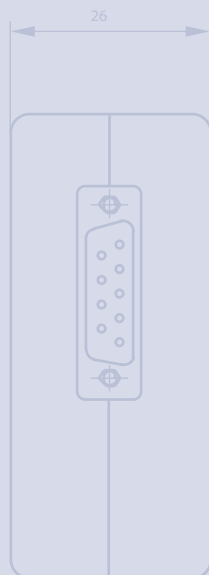
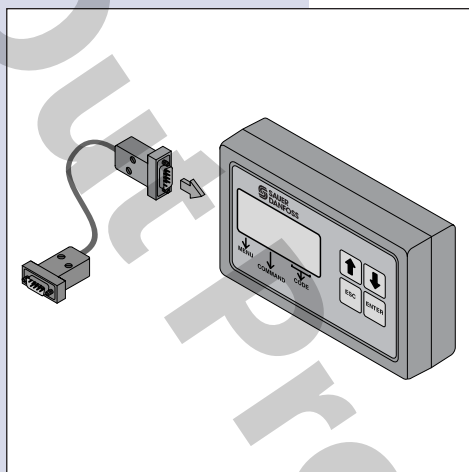

DESCRIPTION

The Sauer-Danfoss Service Device SUSMIC-DIA 1 is designed for use as a setup service and diagnostic tool.

During field service additional tools like a multi-meter or frequency-meter is not generally needed. No complicated connection is necessary. The separate connection cable must be connected with the SUSMIC-DIA 1 and the Digital Controller to start the service job.

Note: The SUSMIC-DIA1 is not water protected. It is a precision measuring tool and it should be handled with care (protect against water, shock and dust).

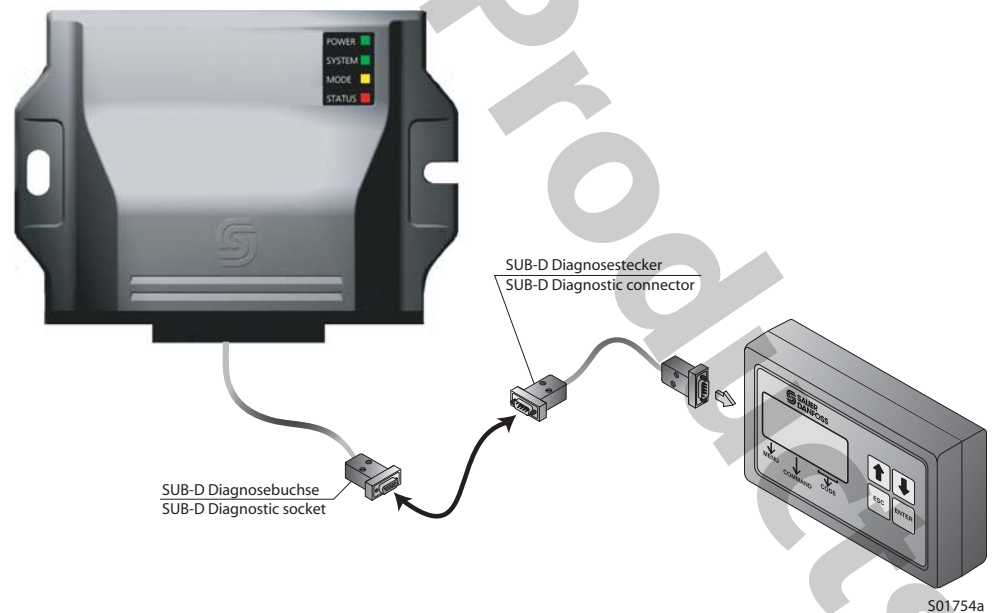
The SUSMIC-DIA 1 provides 3 different procedures:

- Sensor/actuator setup procedure
- Error check procedure
- Sensor/actuator check procedure

CONNECTION

Connect the SUB-D connector with the SUB-D socket (which is connected with the digital electronic) at the machine.

SUB-D connection



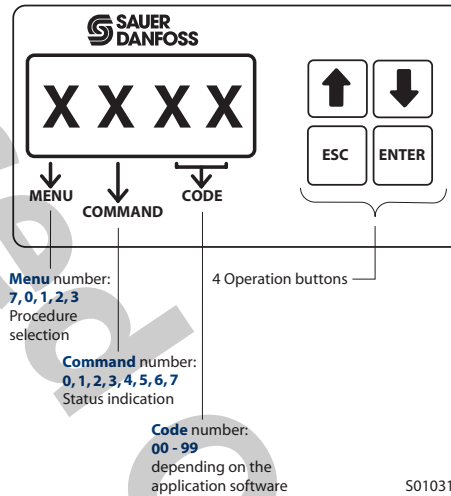

DISPLAY

The display of the SUSMIC-DIA 1 is a four digit display.

Menu Numbers

To get into the separate procedures, the SUSMIC-DIA 1 provides the following menu numbers, which are indicated with the first number in the display.

- 7** = Disconnect
- 0** = Main Menu
- 1** = Sensor Setup
- 2** = Sensor Error
- 3** = Sensor Check

Command Numbers

The SUSMIC-DIA 1 provides the following command numbers, which are indicated with the second number in the display.

- 0** = Set Max
- 1** = Set Mid
- 2** = Set Min
- 3** = Set Def
- 4** = Increase
- 5** = Input Error
- 6** = Status Indicator
- 7** = Status Indicator

Code Numbers

The code numbers are the third and fourth number in the display.

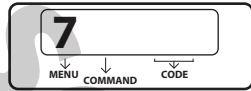
00 - 99 = depending on the application software

GENERAL

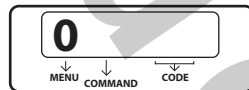
After connect the SUSMIC-DIA 1 with a Digital Controller the service job can be started.

ACTIVATION

1. Switch "OFF" ignition of the Digital Controller.
2. Switch "ON" the ignition. The display shows:



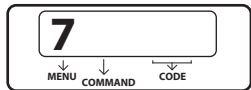
3. To start the communication between the Digital Controller and the Service Device SUSMIC-DIA 1 the **ENTER** button must be pushed. Now you are in the communication Procedure. The display shows:



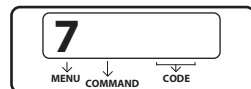
4. To select a procedure (sensor setup, sensor error, sensor check) use buttons **↑** and **↓**. Push the **ENTER** button to start the selected procedure.
5. During communication with the SUSMIC-DIA 1 the digital controller gives no output.

DEACTIVATION

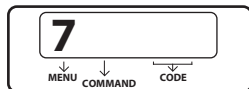
1. The main menu and all other menus can be quit by pushing the **ESC** button.
2. After pushing the **ESC** button, the display shows:



3. The communication link may only be unplugged, if the display shows:



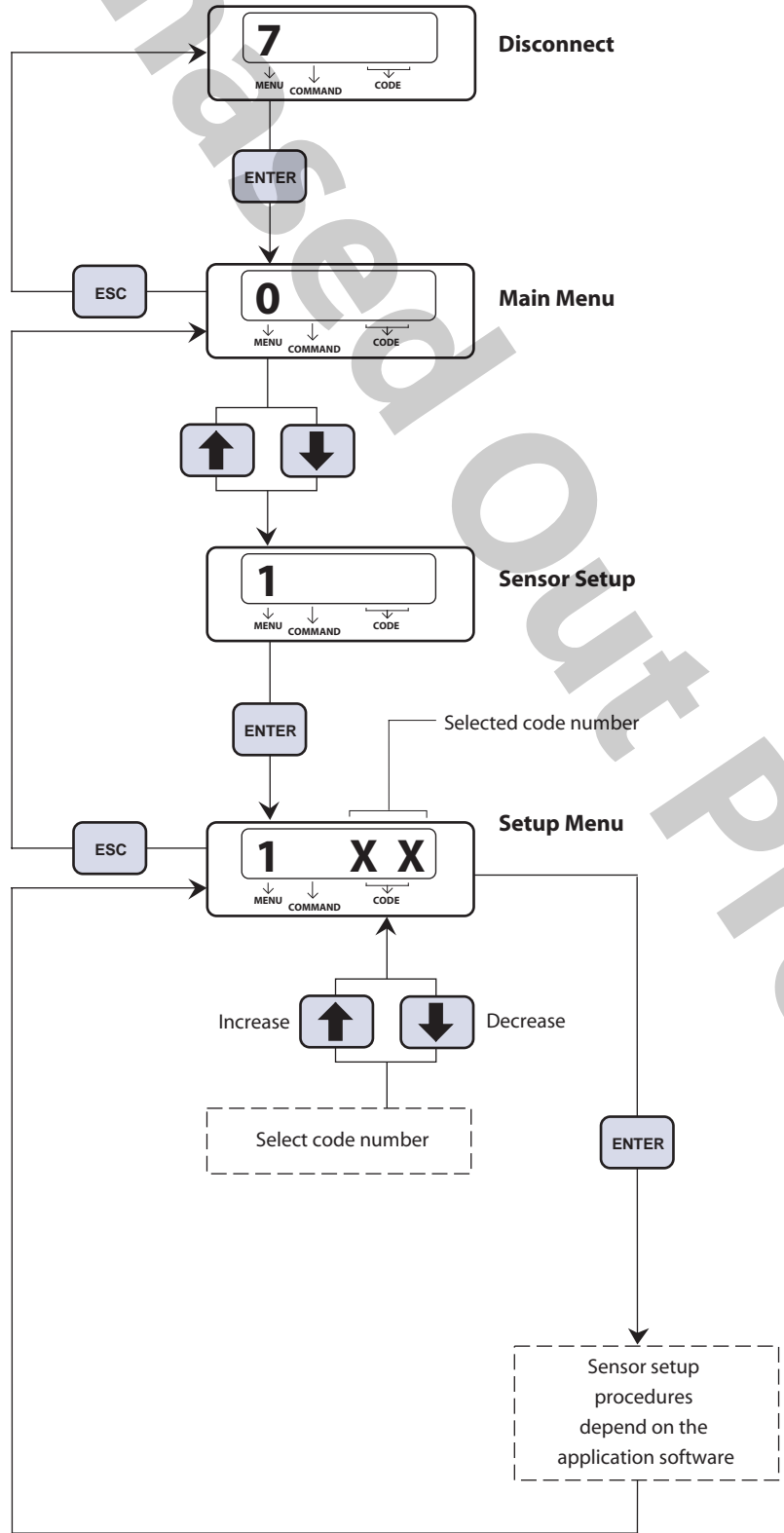
Note: The setup values and adjustment times will be saved in the Digital Controller, when you exit the setup menu (see flow chart) with the **ESC** button until the display shows:



In that **"DISCONNECT"** state the system is running. The data will be lost if the SUSMIC-DIA 1 is disconnected before you go to status **"7"**.

SENSOR/ACTUATOR SETUP PROCEDURE

This setup menu will be shown if you select menu number **1**.



Push **ENTER** to activate the main menu **0**.

Select with buttons **↑** or **↓** the sensor/actuator setup menu **1**.

Push **ENTER** to activate the sensor/actuator setup menu **1**.

Select with buttons **↑** or **↓** the special code number **XX** (the code numbers depend on the application software).

Push **ENTER** to activate the setup procedure for the selected sensor.

Note: If an undefined procedure code number is selected, i.e. **66**, the display shows:

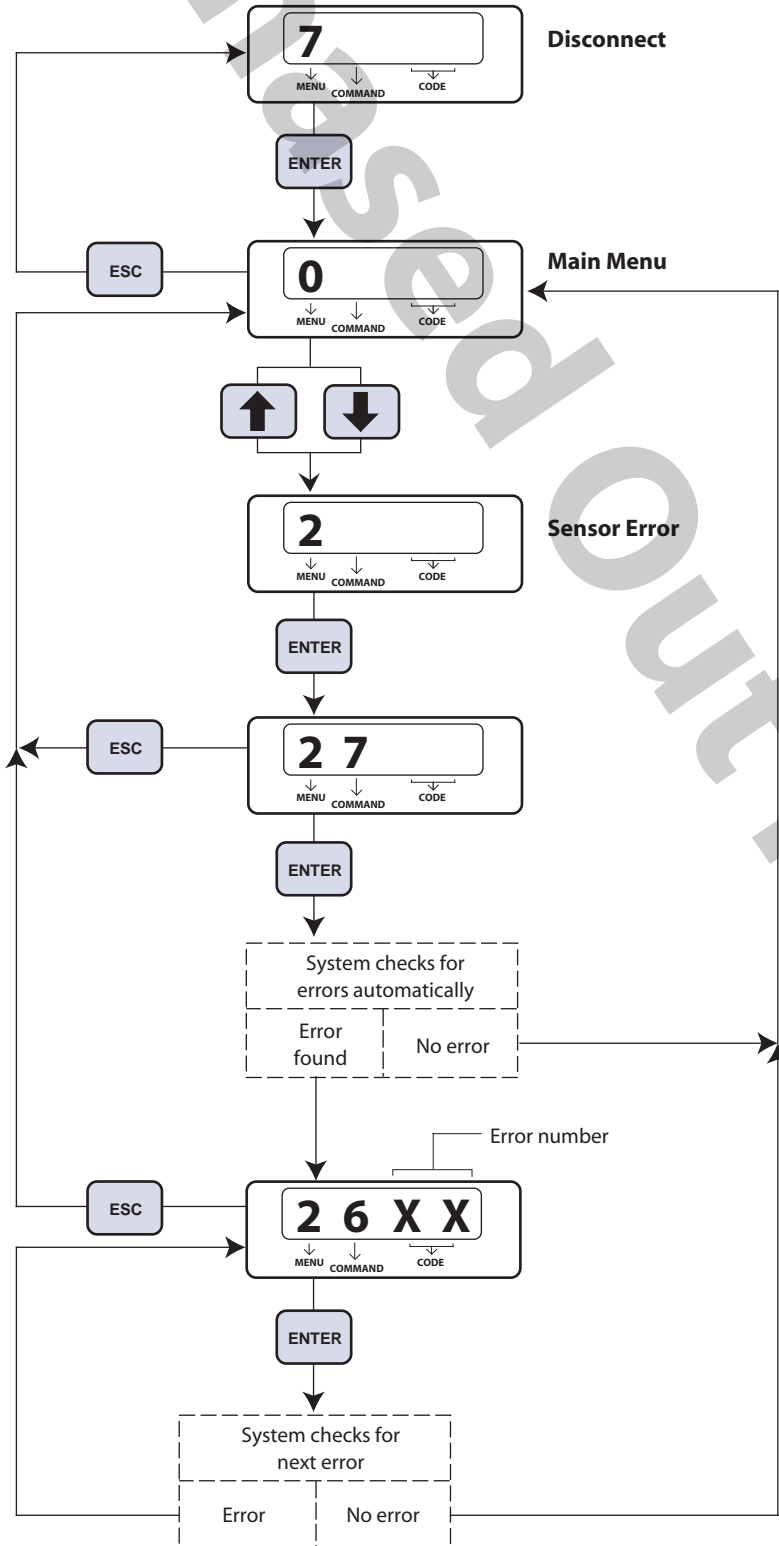


and the command number **(5)** flashes for a short time. After this, the selection can be changed with the buttons **↑** or **↓**.

ERROR CHECK PROCEDURE

This error menu will be shown if you select menu number **2**.



Push **ENTER** to activate the main menu **0**.

Select with buttons **↑** or **↓** the error check menu **2**.

Push **ENTER** to activate the error check menu **2**. The display shows **7** as command.

Push **ESC** to leave the procedure without searching for errors.

Push **ENTER** to start the procedure. The systems checks for errors.

If an error is indicated, the display shows the error number and **6** as command.

Push **ENTER** again, to see further errors.

Push **ESC** to leave the procedure.

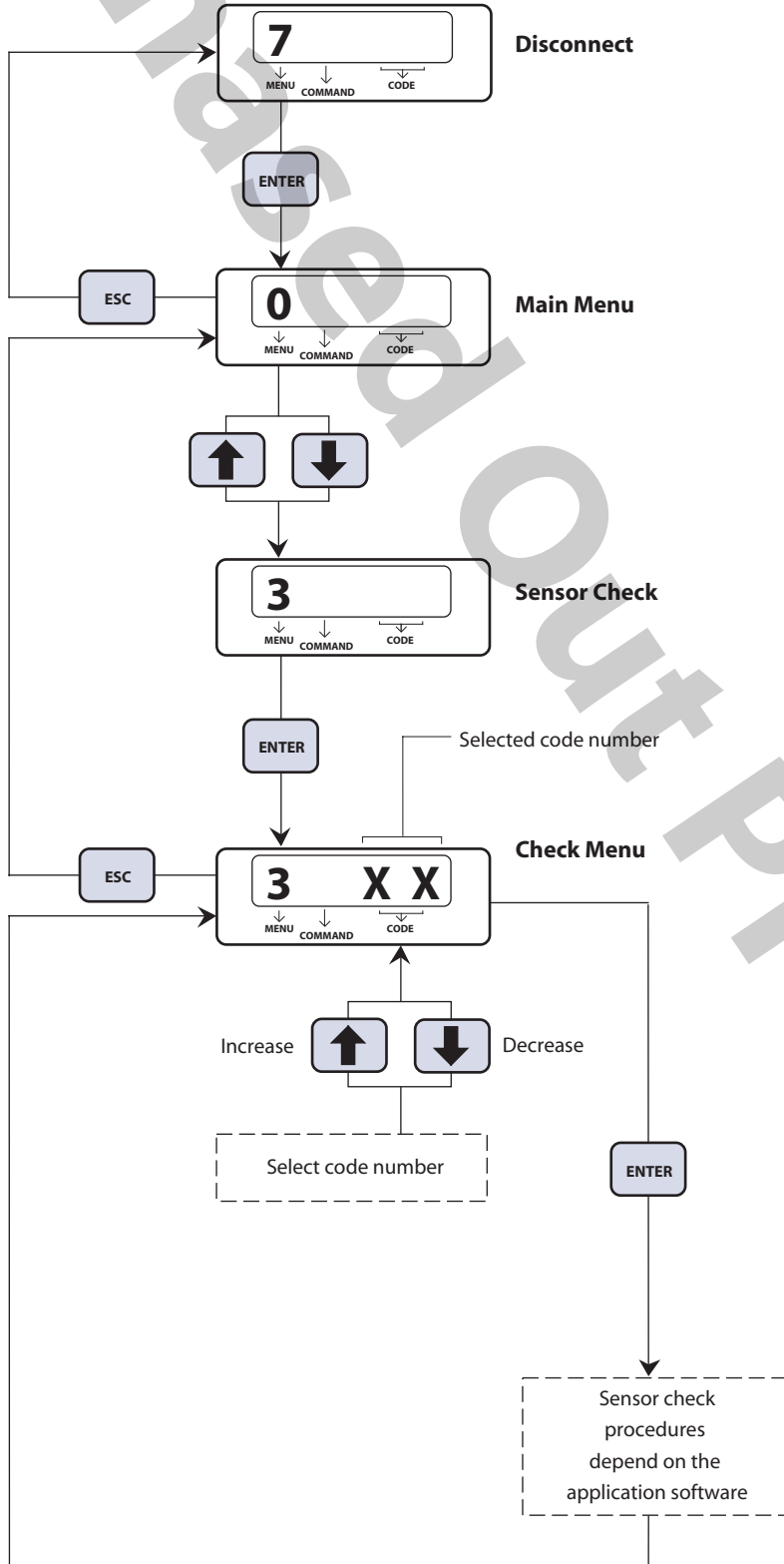
If no errors are found, the display shows **7** as command.

If no more errors are found, the system switches back to the main menu automatically.

SENSOR/ACTUATOR CHECK PROCEDURE

This check menu will be shown if you select menu number **3**.



Push **ENTER** to activate the main menu **0**.

Select with buttons **↑** or **↓** the sensor/actuator check menu **3**.

Push **ENTER** to activate the sensor/actuator check menu **3**.

Select with buttons **↑** or **↓** the special code number **XX** (the code numbers depend on the application software).

Push **ENTER** to activate the check procedure for the selected sensor.

Note: If an undefined procedure code number is selected, i.e. **66**, the display shows:



and the command number (**5**) flashes for a short time. After this, the selection can be changed with the buttons **↑** or **↓**.
