## How to connect multiple EKE 1C to MMIGRS2

## **EKE 1C to MMIGRS2**

- Connect CAN RJ cable (part #080G0075) between CAN RJ port on MMIGRS2 to CAN RJ port on first EKE 1C.
- 2. If initially prompted with BIOS screen, choose "Application". Otherwise, if overview screen is displayed, proceed to step 3.







- 3. Go to Setup&Service menu by holding "Enter" button for approx. 3 seconds. If prompted for password, default login is 300.
- 4. Scroll down to Communication and press Enter. Then press Enter on "Controller" option to set EKE address. Use Up/Down arrows to select desired address and press Enter.








- 5. Repeat steps 2-4 for additional EKE controllers, ensuring separate address assigned to each.
- 6. Connect CAN wiring between CAN H, CAN L, and GND terminals as shown below. For more than two EKE's, use point-to-point daisy-chain.



7. To switch display view between controllers, hold "X" and "Enter" buttons simultaneously until BIOS menu is displayed. Choose "MCX SELECTION" from menu, and "MAN SELECTION" from 2nd menu. Then use Up/Down arrows to scroll to desired address and press Enter.







## If connection to EKE's is unsuccessful:

- a. Ensure MMIGRS has jumper between CAN R and H terminals
- b. In Setup&Service menu, go to Communication menu and ensure CANBus baud rate is same on all controllers (typically 50k).
