As a manufacturer of electronic products, controls and sensors, Danfoss recognizes its Producer Responsibility according the WEEE-Directive 2012/19/EU and embraces the opportunity to help protect and preserve our environment by providing safe means to dispose of electrical, electronic and battery waste.

We have therefore created the Danfoss Takeback and Recycling program as part of our Group Product Compliance Program. Customers can be confident that relevant Danfoss products will be managed responsibly by end-of-life of the products.

Disposal note

This symbol on the product indicates that it may not be disposed of as household waste.

It must be handed over to the applicable take-back scheme for the recycling of electrical and electronic equipment.

- Dispose of the product through channels provided for this purpose.
- Batteries and lamps should be easy to separate from the products.
- Selected products from Danfoss can store personal data. It is therefore
 your responsibility to delete personal data from Danfoss products before
 you recycle them.
- Comply with all local and currently applicable laws and regulations.

Recycling Services

Danfoss has partnered with RENE AG, who is specialist with end-of-life electronic products and batteries to provide a takeback network service. This enables us to offer customers in Europe access to a European network, and the capability to recycle, refurbish or reuse our products, diverting them from landfill or incineration and reducing our environmental impacts. RENE AG uses facilities that apply the environmental standard ISO 14001 ensuring returned products are disposed of in an environmentally safe manner.

Free Recycling for Business Customers

Danfoss provides a free recycling service in EU member states where our products are sold. This provides our customers with the option to ensure that end-of-life products are managed in an environmental responsible way and recycling is carried out at approved facilities in accordance with ISO 14001 requirements.

Collection costs

Recycling is free, however, in some countries customers will be required to take the responsibility for shipment of end-of-life products to a specified collection facility. Customers are free to make their own transport arrangements or to use the service of Danfoss. This can be agreed when making a Takeback Request.
