

# DEVI Connect

## End User License Agreement and Disclaimer

**By downloading and installing or using the DEVI Connect app (hereinafter the Application) stated above on your device you accept this Agreement and terms below. If you cannot accept this Agreement no license is granted, you are not entitled to use the Application and the Application must be uninstalled and all copies deleted.**

### **1. License**

This end user license agreement and disclaimer (“Agreement”) is entered into between Danfoss A/S or its Affiliates (each of which is referred to as “Danfoss”) and you as an end user (“You” or “User”). In this Agreement “Affiliate” shall mean an entity directly or indirectly controlled by Danfoss A/S whether by shares or voting rights.

Upon acceptance of this Agreement Danfoss grants You a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, royalty-free, worldwide license (“License”) to install and use the DEVI smart heating system\*, Danfoss (“Application”), for User’s own use on any device that User owns or controls. The License is granted subject to User’s compliance with the terms of this Agreement.

\* = DEVI smart heating system consists presently of DEVI Connect app, DEVI Control app, DEVIreg™ Basic thermostat, DEVIreg™ Room thermostat, DEVIreg™ Display Connect thermostat, DEVIreg™ InControl thermostat, and DEVI Connect Zigbee gateway.

### **2. Intended purpose**

The Application is intended to be used by you as a private person to deliver the Applications services to you and to execute your instructions through the Application and to improve default settings and enhance the performance of the Application in general. In addition, Danfoss may process other types of personal data provided by the individual applicants in various free text fields on a voluntary basis.

### **3. Use of (personal) data**

By your registration and use of DEVI smart heating system - you provide your data including personal data to Danfoss A/S, Nordborgvej 81, DK-6430 Nordborg, Denmark, being the parent company of the Danfoss Group. Danfoss A/S is the Data Controller for the processing of personal data in respect of DEVI smart heating system. In this regard, Danfoss may process your (personal) data of the following data categories

a) Data you provide us with related to your input:

- Account or Profile Data: When you register an account with us, we may collect your name and contact details, such as your email address, phone number, user name, and login credentials. During your interaction with our Products, we may further collect your nickname, profile picture, country code, language preference or time zone information into your account.
- Feedback: When using feedback and suggestion features in our Products, we will collect your email address, mobile phone number and your feedback content to address your problems and solve device failures on a timely basis.
- Network diagnosis: When you decide to share network diagnosis log with Danfoss please be aware that you share email address, IP addresses, App Code, Carrier name, etc. Please find Danfoss contact information under [DEVI.com](https://www.danfoss.com) site.

b) Data required to fulfil the Intended Purpose (see 2.):

- Device Information: When you interact with our Product, we automatically collect device information, such as the MAC address of your devices, IP address, wireless connection information, operating system type and version, application version number, push notification identifier, log files and mobile network information.
- Usage Data: During your interaction with our Sites and Services, we automatically collect usage data relating to visits, clicks, downloads, messages sent/received, and other usage of our Sites and Services.
- Log Information: When you use our app, the system and exception log may be processed
- Location Information: We may collect information about your real-time precise or non-precise geo-location when you use our specific Products or Services.

- Basic Information of Smart Devices: When you connect your Smart Devices with our Products or Services, we may collect basic information about your Smart Devices such as device name, device ID, online status, activation time, firmware version, and upgrade information.
- Information Reported by Smart Devices: Depending on the different Smart Devices you elect to connect with our Products or Services, we may collect different information reported by your Smart Devices.

The processing of the personal data is lawful because it is either (i) necessary for the performance this Agreement or prior to entering into this Agreement and/or (ii) necessary for the purpose of the legitimate interest pursued by Danfoss which is not overridden by your interests or fundamental rights of privacy and freedom and/or (iii) necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which Danfoss is subject.

Danfoss processes your Personal Data for the minimum period necessary for the Intended Purpose, unless there is a specific legal requirement for us to keep the data for a longer retention period. We determine the appropriate retention period based on the amount, nature, and sensitivity of your Personal Data. After the retention period ends, your Personal Data will be deleted. When we are unable to do so for technical reasons, we will ensure that appropriate measures are in place to prevent any further processing of your Personal Data.

Your rights concerning personal data can be executed through respective functionality in the DEVI Connect app including requests for data deletion.

- i. be used for any purpose except in compliance with this Agreement,
- ii. be copied or reproduced in any form, or

- iii. be modified, rented, leased, sold, distributed, reversed engineered or exploited commercially.

Danfoss reserves the right to change, suspend, remove or disable User's access at any time without notice. The Danfoss name, Danfoss logo and other Danfoss trademarks, graphics and logos are trademarks or registered trademarks of Danfoss or its affiliated companies. User is granted no right or license with respect to such trademarks.

## **5. Third Party Components**

The Application may include certain third party software components ("Third Party Components") including open source and free software components, each of which has its own copyright and its own license conditions ("Third Party License"). A list of included Software Components and their respective licenses can be found in clause 11.

To the extent any Third Party License grants the User rights to use, copy or modify the Open Source Component that are broader or narrower than the rights granted in this Agreement, then such rights shall take precedence over the rights and restrictions granted in this Agreement solely for such Third Party Components.

The Application is provided on an "as is" and "as available" basis for the intended purposes as determined by Danfoss only and any use hereof is at User's sole risk. The Application and results and information generated thereby cannot substitute technical advice but must be verified by the User, they are not promises and should not be relied on as accurate data or analyses. You acknowledge that the Application and the service, including the remote access, are not error-free nor 100% reliable and may not be 100% available.

DANFOSS DISCLAIMS ALL WARRANTIES AND CONDITIONS REGARDING THE APPLICATION AND CONNECTED SERVICES, WHETHER EXPRESS, IMPLIED, OR STATUTORY, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, CONDITIONS OF MERCHANTABILITY, SATISFACTORY QUALITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, ACCURACY AND NON-INFRINGEMENT OF THIRD PARTIES' RIGHTS.
